## SCVF Bylaw Revision Summary

### Introduction

- The current Bylaws haven't been revised since 2012. The draft has been updated to the current practices of SCVF and best practice recommendations.
- The draft strives to make the Bylaws easier to understand, with less duplication, while still being compliant to laws and regulations.
- A table of contents will be added once the draft Bylaws are approved.
- The draft attempts to balance flexibility and protection of the foundation.
- The Bylaws Committee used the Minnesota Council of Nonprofits and other resources as guides.

### Significant Revisions

1. Verbiage reduced and simplified throughout the Bylaws.
2. Section order rearranged to reduce duplication.
3. Added a "Purpose" section to comply with IRS requirements to maintain nonprofit status.
4. Clarified terms of office for Chair and Vice Chair as two-year terms with annual reconfirmation.
5. Added "Variance" to Board Powers and Duties.
6. Added a simplified "Conflict of Interest" to Board Powers and Duties.
7. Removed section where Board members can be replaced for breach of fiduciary duty since Board members can be removed with or without cause.
8. Removed section about replacing Board members for failure to produce a reasonable return.
9. 2012 version of the Bylaws require a treasurer and secretary even though we have not been electing these officers. The duties have been clarified and secretary combined with Vice Chair.
10. Updated the Chair's duties.
11. Added Immediate Past Chair to list of officers.
12. Updated the President's duties.
13. Simplified delegation of duties to assistants and additional officers, including staff.
14. Combined multiple references to quorum and voting into one article.
15. Added "and Investment" to the name of the Finance committee.
16. Updated Executive and Finance and Investment committee descriptions to current practice.
17. Only executive and finance committees are required per Minnesota law. Specific references to other committees have been removed to allow flexibility in determining the committees to establish and their names.
18. Separated out "Affiliate Foundations" as its own section due to the importance of affiliated community foundations and clarified the wording.
19. Removed dated details like names of funds, some of which we aren't using.
20. Included current non-discrimination categories.
21. Updated signature section and added revision dates.
